2 Let each of us please his neighbor for his good **to build him up**. Romans 15, NET

Definition of “build up:” building, construction, a physical edifice; by extension: building up, edification, strengthening, developing another person’s life through acts and words of love and encouragement

God gives us clues as to what “building up” looks like: It is a pursuit, an ongoing project, not “one and done”. It will ultimately lead to peace. It will benefit their spiritual development. It isn’t about what I want but what they need.

Instructions: Read over these two verses. Think about what they mean. Read them in other translations. Write them on a 3 x 5 card and memorize them. Meditate on their implications. Pray about ways you could put them into practice. Now make a list of Christian brothers and sisters God has placed in your life. How specifically could you practice these verses in their lives?
