Definition of "build up:" building, construction, a physical edifice; by extension: building up, edification, strengthening, developing another person's life through acts and words of love and encouragement

God gives us clues as to what "building up" looks like: It is a pursuit, an ongoing project, not "one and done". It will ultimately lead to peace. It will benefit their spiritual development. It isn't about what I want but what they need.
